Nonetheless they object as the development could impact the parish and there isn't time to investigate the issues that concern them including: the road is very narrow so any extra traffic is a concern; if services such as sewage and surface water are connected to mains sewers, this might impact on the sewage capacity of the Carlton system, which already has issues. | in the committee report except for foul sewage which is not explicitly mentioned. The application form indicates foul sewage is to be disposed of via a backage treatment plant. The scheme would not therefore impact upon the existing sewage capacity.
