It would perhaps be prudent, therefore, to give the figure for estimates of the number of problem gamblers as a percentage (0.5%) rather than a national figure.	Additional wording added.
	We welcome the statement in paragraph 5.2.6 that conditions may be applied by the Authority if it is felt necessary and appropriate and where there is a specific evidenced risk. This paragraph should be expanded so that it is clear that conditions may be applied by the Authority where there is a specific evidenced risk that is not adequately addressed by the policies, procedures and mitigation measures detailed by the applicant in its risk assessment.
