We want our residents to live and work in a clean, safe and green environment that will enhance their quality of life and build upon civic pride.

We will work in partnership with other organisations and the community to provide a clean and safe district and to protect and enhance the environment of Newark and Sherwood.

#### Campaign Aim

This campaign will work to make Newark and Sherwood **Cleaner, Safer and Greener** by changing behaviour across the district using the tools of education and engagement, and deterrence. We will work in partnership with other organisations and the community to achieve our mission statement.

#### **Mission Statement**

To make the district a **Cleaner, Safer and Greener** place. We want to work in partnership with others to encourage and enable our residents to take a greater role in determining the quality of life in their local communities and to enhance civic pride. However, for those affected by anti-social behaviour and environmental crimes, this campaign will underline an uncompromising approach to criminality and reaffirm that Newark and Sherwood is not a soft-touch for those who seek to blight our communities.

#### Measure of Success

We will ensure we measure our success and have a range of measures already identified and in place that will let us know how well we are doing in achieving our aims and objectives.



### Campaign Objectives

The objectives for the campaign are outlined below. These are shared objectives. They will be achieved in partnership with residents, businesses, key partners and Parish and Town Councils because the **Cleaner, Safer, Greener** agenda is a joint responsibility.

Reduce litter levels by supporting and encouraging community litter picks	Strengthen and coordinate the council response to nuisance neighbour complaints	Increase the percentage of household waste sent for reuse, recycling or composting
Take an uncompromising approach to the use of Fixed Penalty Charges for environmental offences	Work with the Police to promote and support the effective use of CCTV	Improve the appearance of streets by reducing the quantity of street clutter, including fly posting, and improving the quality of signage including traffic and directional signage.

## Campaign Delivery

Newark and Sherwood District Council will deliver this campaign using the twin approach of education and engagement, and deterrence.

Education and Engagement

- We will encourage and support our residents to take ownership of their role in improving their local environment and taking pride in their district.
- We will engage with our residents to improve the reporting of offences and grot spots to enable targeted action.
- We will encourage and support community litter picks.
- We will provide information to residents to support an increase in recycling rates.



#### Deterrence

- We will work in partnership with key organisations to improve reporting of offences.
- We will take an uncompromising approach to criminality, anti-social behaviour and complaints by taking greater enforcement actions, such as the application of Fixed Penalty

Charges.
