# 1.0 Background

- 1.1 A new applicant for a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Drivers or Private Ambulance Drivers Licence has to undergo various checks. These include a: Disclosure & Barring check; DVLA check; two references are required; Group II medical; and knowledge & ability tests.
- 1.2 This report covers the period from 1 July to 30 September 2023 inclusive and sets out the range and number of licence applications during this period. It also highlights any activity required as a result of the applications:

## 1.3 <u>Street Collections</u>
