Section 1.4 / 2.2 or 4.0??

Within these sections is there an opportunity to promote compliance with other legislation as part of holding a gambling license.

For example, and only as an example – it is the expectation of the Authority granting the license that all other relevant legislation is complied with in full be that Health and Safety, Food Licensing, Fire Safety,

The section about updating local risk assessments could lend itself nicely to this – 2.2.4??

We only ask as something similar has been used effectively across the county in their respective liquor licensing policies.
