2	<p>The options that the application recommends are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To revoke the premises licence,</li> <li>• To vary the premises licence in order to reduce the opening hours: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Sunday to Thursday 20:00 – 23:30</li> <li>○ Friday and Saturday 20:00 – 0:30 the following morning</li> <li>○ Other hours as the committee sees fit,</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Limit the patrons within the smoking area to no more than 5 people at a time and enforce with door supervisors,</li> <li>• Prohibit the use of the outside area of the premises by customers,</li> <li>• Prohibit use of the outside area to the rear after 23:00</li> <li>• Require the adaptation of the inside of the premises to include a 'quiet' area for those who wish to chat and relax away from the music.</li> </ul>

6	<b>Appendix I</b> – Meade – Have suffered with disruption and noise from the customers of Club X and the family are not able to go about their normally family life during the evenings when the club is open. The Meade family do not want the building to continue to be used as a night club.
