Report Summary	
Application for Review of a Premises Licence – The Roaring Meg, Barnby Gate, Newark	
For Members to consider an application to review the premises licence for the The Roaring Meg, Barnby Gate, Newark	
That Members consider the review application and the representations made for The Roaring Meg, Newark and take the steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives. The steps available on determination of review applications are:	
 To modify the conditions of the licence To exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence To remove the Designated Premises Supervisor To suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months To revoke the licence To take no action 	

1.0 Background

- 1.1 The application to review the premises licence was received from Catrin Styles, Environmental Health on 6 November 2024 and was submitted on the grounds of public safety. A visit to the premises was undertaken on 9 October 2024 following information received by Environmental Health. During the visit safety issues were identified concerning live and exposed electrical wiring and a damaged electrical installation structure. Following notification of the issues to the Premises Licence Holder, Cycle PS Ltd, they stated that they had no responsibility for repair and maintenance of the premises, and this was down to the leaseholder. This arrangement suggests that there is a lack of accountability for the state of the premises and the Premises Licence Holder is not able to ensure public safety is maintained.
